Bishop, Dr. Billy. Ray Johns was born on September 12, 1956 in Austin, TX to the late Wa de Johns, Sr. and Mary Glen Woods. He was one of twelve children. He is survived by thr ee brothers, Wade Johns Jr., Otis Harris, Billy Joe Harris, and three sisters, Beatrice War e, Louise Cyphers, and Emma Johns. He graduated from Albuquerque High School in Alb uquerque New Mexico. He joined the United States Army in October 1976. Bishop Johns r eceived Jesus Christ as his Lord and Savior at an early age; 19 years old to be exact. On October 1, 1976, Bishop Johns was united in holy matrimony to Leticia Johns. They ha ve six daughters: Felicia Mixon, Mary Johns, Jessica Johns, Melissa Johns, Erika Johns, and Jennifer Johns-Charles. This year they would have celebrated 43 years of marriage. In 1976, Bishop was a faithful member of God's House Apostolic Church under the pastor alship of Elder Eugene Stewart of Albuquerque, New Mexico. Bishop Johns served at Go d's House Church from 1975 to 1980 and then moved to Laredo, Texas where he fellowshi pped at Central Assembly of God under the pastoralship of Rev. Pat Robinson. He served there until the middle of 1984 and then moved to Austin, Texas. In 1984, Bishop Johns join ed Grace Temple Apostolic Church where he was ordained as a minister and deacon and continued serving until 1987. Bishop Johns was called on a mission to help build churche s. Bishop Johns then started a ministry in his home and recruited Dr. Craig High of Fort W orth, Texas to be Pastor of the ministry, which is called Greater Peace Christian Church. Bi shop Johns served as a minister and a deacon and the church grew to be a great ministry which is still going on today. Bishop Johns was called to Lifeline Evangelistical Ministries u nder the leadership of Dr. Rebecca Washington-Berry, Chief Apostle/ Presiding Prelate Fai th Ministries International Network of Churches, Inc. He served until the Lord called him to pioneer another ministry in 1994 until he retired, which is Greater New Life Christian Chur ch. God has used this ministry to change lives. He was responsible for the singing career of his daughters, "Images of Christ," and their first CD, "You Can Make It." Bishop Johns al so has founded two non-profit organizations which are called S.T.A.N.D., which was found

ed in 1996 and also Koinonia, a Christian fellowship of churches where churches come to gether for authentic and true fellowship (which is the meaning of Koinonia in Greek "authe ntic fellowship"). God gave Bishop Johns a vision to bring people to true worship through e ducation, proclamation, and dedication to the work of God. He was ordained as a Bishop on October 2002 under Faith Ministries International Network of Churches. He is listed in Faith Ministries International Network of Churches Incorporation bylaws as one of the First Bishops ordained in the global organization. Bishop Johns received an Honorary "Doctor of Divinity" from Elbon-Solutions College on October 31, 2004.

Bishop Johns leaves to cherish his memories a loving and devoted wife, Leticia Johns; 6 d aughters, Felicia Mixon (Byron), Mary Johns, Jessica Johns, Melissa Johns, Erika Johns, and Jennifer Johns-Charles (Bobby), seventeen grandchildren, five great children, 2 broth ers, Dennis "Duck" Johns and Michael Johns, 3 sisters, Dorothy Vaughn, Jo Ann Johns, and Janet Johns; and a host of relatives and friends.
