Obituary

Alan attended school at Blackshear Elementary School, Allan Junior High School and graduated from Johnston High School. He accepted Christ at an early age and received the plan of Salvation before he transitioned to be with the Lord.

Alan spent some time living in California with his uncle. Upon returning to Texas he became a member of the Buffalo Soldier Trail Riding program through the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department, which offers living history programs that explore the lives of Buffalo Soldiers, including life on the trail. At one point he owned three horses, which was his passion, as he loved being a cowboy. He worked and retired from the City of Austin as a Machine Operator for 16 years and 4 months. He was a member of East 19th Street Baptist Church for 20 years. He loved family gatherings and could never eat enough food, so he always

He prided himself with grilling and always brought his grill to family functions.
