Annie Lee Taylor Tyrone was born October 25, 1942 in Taylor, Texas to Arthur Taylor and Minnie Rollie Taylor. She attended and graduated from O. L. Price High School in Taylor Texas, class of 1961. She received her Bachelor's Degree from Huston-Tillotson College in 1967.

Annie Tyrone accepted Jesus Christ at an early age at Zion Chapel in Taylor, Texas. Her dedication to the Lord was reflected by her work in the church where she served in the choir and various mission ministries.

Annie worked twelve and half years for the Monsanto Company in St. Louis, Missouri. In 1979, Annie received a phone call while still living in St. Louis. It was from the love of her life, Elvin Tyrone. Six months later, after receiving that phone call, they were united in Holy Matrimony on November 7, 1979. She packed up, and left St. Louis to be with her loving husband in Austin, Texas.

In 1979, she began working for the Texas Agricultural Department for ten years. She transferred to the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission (TNRCC) where she worked for eleven years. She retired from TNRCC in 2001.

In 1989, Annie became the First Lady of the Little Zion Baptist Church of Manor, Texas. Annie was a blessing to her church family for 27 years before her health failed her. She served in the choir, Mission II, Minister's and Wives, and as a mentor to Jr Mission. Wherever she served in the church, she blessed the auxiliaries with her warm presence and generous spirit. Her

knowledge of the Bible and the teachings from Titus 2 to her younger members will leave an indelible mark for generations.

Annie was also an aspiring actress. She was featured in several commercials including a nationally syndicated Greyhound Bus Advertisement that aired on television and in magazines. Annie thoroughly enjoyed this departure from her regular life.

Annie served in numerous ministries at the local, state, and national levels. Her greatest joy was found in serving as First Lady of the Little Zion Baptist Church. Annie was known by everyone as a fantastic First Lady.

Annie was preceded in death by her parents and only brother, Arthur Taylor, Jr.

Annie leaves to cherish her memory her beloved husband, Elvin E. Tyrone; Daughter, Yolanda (Roscoe) Smith of Rowlett, Texas; son, Anthony Tyrone, Sr. of College Station, Texas; Daughter, Kimberly Renee Tyrone of College Station, Texas; grandsons, Nicholas Smith and Anthony Tyrone, Jr.; Godchildren, Cheryl Washington Harrison, Marcus Jones, Sr., and Kimberly Hill.
