### The Life and Legacy of Carroll Brown

Carroll Ann Williams Brown of Pflugerville, Texas was born to the late Clarence Williams and Robbie Henderson Williams of Austin, Texas. She accepted Christ as her Lord and Savior at an early age and was baptized in 1954 at the Greater Mt. Zion Baptist Church under the pastoral leadership of Rev. J. H. Washington. She remained a faithful member of the church for over 70 years. She was a founding member of the Junior Ushers and served as an usher for many years.

Carroll Ann Williams and Charles Van Brown were joined in holy matrimony on November 21, 1964, at Greater Mt. Zion Baptist Church in Austin, Texas. They were married for 48 years until his death on January 24, 2013. To this union two sons were born, Christopher Van and Clinton Avery Brown.

Carroll was a dedicated employee of the Internal Revenue Service for 35 years. Throughout her career, she enjoyed numerous positions, but her proudest moment was achieving the role as Senior Management Analyst in the Taxpayer Advocate Office. Over her years of service, she received numerous awards including the Albert Gallatin Award for Distinguished Services of at least 30 years for her loyalty and dedication to the Service. After retiring, Carroll and Charles moved to the smaller community of Bastrop, Texas to enjoy life at a slower pace. They enjoyed this time together until Charles passed away in 2013. Carroll then moved to Pflugerville, Texas to be closer to her children and grandchildren.

Carroll departed this life on March 24, 2025. She was preceded in death by her father and mother, Clarence and Robbie Williams, and her husband Charles Van Brown. Those remaining to cherish her memory are her sons, Christopher Brown (Tracie) of Hutto, Texas and Clinton Brown (Latrece) of Austin, Texas; granddaughters, Charlize and Camdyn Brown; and a host of other relative and friends.
