



## Catherine Wright

December 18, 1922 - June 27, 2016

Sister Catherine Sneed Wright was born December 18, 1922. She was the only child born to the union of Alice Berry and Robert Sneed. She departed this life on June 12, 2016.

Sister Wright attended school at Riner Branch and the Old L. C. Anderson High.

She was united in marriage to Hermet Jesus Wright on April 6, 1940. Seven children were born to this union, all girls.

She professed a hop in Christ as a young adult and was baptized by her father-in-law, Rev. T. A. Wright. She became a faithful member of the Pleasant Valley Missionary Baptist Church where she sang alto in the choir along side her best friend Sister Ellen Franklin Dawkins. She often taught Sunday School and served in other areas of the church as well. After moving to the city, she moved her membership to the Barton Springs Missionary Baptist Church. After Barton Springs closed, she united with the Friendly Will Missionary Baptist Church on March 15, 1992. She was faithful in her attendance until her health failed in 2015.

Sister Wright was very industrious; she would locate fresh fruit that she was allowed to pick. She made preserves from figs, peaches and watermelon rinds. She made jelly from plums and wild grapes. She also used the grape juice to make wine that she used season the fruit cakes she made each year for Christmas. She raised ducks and used the meat and eggs to supplement the family's food supply.

Sister Wright was preceded in death by her husband, parents, a daughter, Linda Katherine King, a sister, Minnie Lee Walker, and great-great grandsons, Ty'Ree Key Clark and Thomas Earl Clark III.

Sister Wright leaves to cherish her memory six daughters, Mary Alice Clark (Earl), Frances Augusta Lee (James) of San Antonio, Texas, Dorothy Nell Gregg, Mona Lisa Ealey, Sundee Nesby (Rick), and Cynthia Wright-Gonzales (Mauricio) of Oklahoma City, Oklahoma; sister Allene Sneed Johnson of Dallas, Texas; seventeen grandchildren, twenty seven great grandchildren, twelve great-great grandchildren; and a host of nieces, nephews, cousins and friends.
