Charles Winston Birmingham I was born on March 13, 1935 to Ulysis and Vonall Birmingham in Sapulpa, Oklahoma. The family moved to Dallas, Texas shortly after Charles' birth. He graduated from Lincoln High School in Dallas, Texas and attended Texas Southern University in Houston, Texas.

As a young child Charles grew up in the church. He joined and was baptized at Sweet Home – The Pinnacle of Praise in 2005 where he was a member until his death.

Charles began his career in the beverage business in 1970 with Pearl Brewing Company in Houston, Texas. He moved to Austin in 1977 as Regional Manager for Miller Brewing Company. He later joined Miller Distributing Company of Austin. In 1985, he ventured into private business ownership, and established a successful janitorial service, which he operated until 1989. He returned to the beverage industry in 1989 as Manager of Sales for Shiner of Austin. Charles ended his career as General Manager of Sales for Manneken Brussel Imports where he retired in 2005. Charles retired after working 35 illustrious years in the beverage industry.

Charles was very community oriented. Throughout his career in the beverage industry, Charles initiated and sponsored numerous fundraisers for Huston-Tillotson University, non-profit organizations, civic organizations, local churches and other worthwhile causes.

Charles had a gregarious personality with a clever entertaining sense of humor. He was an attentive engaged listener, who gave each individual his

undivided attention. After he became homebound due to illness, he enjoyed keeping up with his friends and relatives by phone to keep current on their lives. Charles was a news and sports enthusiast and a very avid cowboy fan, "How 'bout them Cowboys!" However, when they lost, he refused to talk to anyone. While homebound he watched and enjoyed the Game Show Network with his sister-in-law and health aide; his favorite show was "The Family Feud."

Charles was preceded in death by his parents, Ulysis and Vonall Birmingham.
