Ernest Walton Clark was born August 8, 1954 at Brackenridge Hospital in Austin, Texas. He was the sixth child of Vernest Harrison and Mamie Clark. He was given the nickname Peter, which he outgrew and changed to "Pete." He accepted Christ early in life, and attended Black's Memorial Baptist Church, under Reverend A. M. Patton. He was baptized under the Montopolis Bridge in Austin, Texas. He education in AISD included (St. John Elementary, Pierce Junior High, and John H. Reagan High School).

He entered the U.S. Army where he completed his education with a GED. Pete served his country for 2 years, and decided it was not life for him. He was permitted an early discharge under other than honorable conditions.
