



## Franklin Barnum Sr.

September 30, 1943 - August 15, 2025

Franklin “Frank” Barnum, a cherished husband, devoted father, proud grandfather, and honorable U.S. Army Veteran, passed away peacefully on August 15, 2025, at the age of 81. Henry, Coretta, Glynnis, Marcus, and Franetta; and his grandchildren, Sydney, David, and Kaylie, who will forever hold him close in their hearts. He is also lovingly remembered by many nieces, nephews, extended family, and friends whose lives he touched so deeply. Frank was preceded in death by his parents, Homer and Lillie, as well as his brothers, Albert and Richard.

A Celebration of Life Service to honor Frank's remarkable journey will be held at St. Stephens Missionary Baptist Church – The North Star (12300 Amherst Drive, Austin, TX 78727) on Saturday, August 30, 2025, at 11:00 AM CST.
