Georgia Ann Harris Booker was born on May 10, 1939, in Plano, Texas, to the late Tatum

Harris and Celestin Davis. She was the eldest of nine children.

Georgia received her education at L.C. Anderson High School and later retired from the

Texas State Teachers Association, after more than twenty years of dedicated service.

Church for over twenty-five years, she served faithfully in many capacities.

She sang in

Christian Church to serve the community, and was an active member of Mission One and Mission Two. She also served as President of the Christian Women's Ministry and was known for feeding the homeless and helping those in need.
