Gladys Young Shaw Hubbard was born May 26, 1922, in Phelan Texas; Bastrop County. She was born to the union of the late Mitchell Young and Hannah Young. Gladys was preceded in death by four brothers; Felton Young, Julius Young, Ernest Lee Young and Robert Young; two sisters Mae Willie (Young) Turner, and Merrill (Young) Jackson. Gladys attended school in Coupland, Texas.

Gladys united with The First Baptist Church at an early age, and then later moved her membership to Zion Chapel Missionary Baptist Church. There Gladys served as a mission sister and sang in the choir until her health failed her.
