Horace Dixon Sr. was born May 22, 1936, in Austin, Texas, to Morise Dixon Sr. and Mrs. Arichard Dixon.

Horace accepted Christ at an early age under the leadership of Reverend Boyd D. Hansbrough of St. Paul Missionary Baptist Church.

Horace attended L. C. Anderson High School in Austin, Texas. He joined the United States Air Force in 1957. Serving 23 years of Military Service. His tour of duty took him to Alabama, Newfoundland, Thailand, South Dakota, England, Abilene, Texas, Japan, Kansas and Oklahoma. He attended Oscar Rose Junior College (Midwest City, Oklahoma). He maintained his membership with St. Paul Missionary Baptist Church while serving in the Military. After retiring from the United States Air Force Horace and his wife moved back home to Austin, Texas. Where he received employment with United States Postal Services. He retired in 2002 from the United States Postal Services. He served as a dedicated Co-Chairman of the Deacon Board and a member of the Brotherhood at St. Paul Missionary Baptist Church under the leadership of Reverend Melvin S. Manor.

His enjoyment was dominos, fishing, taking pictures, garden and traveling. He was united in Holy Matrimony to Rebecca Reed, November 16, 1957. To this union, three children were born.

He was preceded in death by his father, Morise Dixon Sr., mother, Arichard

Dixon, brother, Morise Dixon Jr. and sister, Clara B. Wright.

He leaves to cherish his memories, his lovely wife Rebecca Dixon of 67 years.
