Ifiok Effiong Enyong was born on March 17, 1956, in Uyo, Akwa Ibom State, Nigeria, to

Obong Dr. Effiong Enyong Udofia and Deaconess Mrs. Lily Effiong Enyong.

From an

early age, it was evident that Ifiok was destined to lead a life marked by purpose, joy,

and service. A devout follower of Jesus Christ, he remained deeply rooted in his faith

throughout his life.

After graduating from Holy Family College in Nigeria in 1974, Ifiok began his professional journey at Standard Bank of Nigeria Plc (now First Bank of Nigeria Plc).

Shortly afterward, he immigrated to the United States to further his education.

He

earned a Bachelor of Business Administration from Texas College, followed by a Master

of Business Administration with a concentration in Finance from the University of North

Texas.

Over the years, Ifiok served in numerous financial leadership roles across various

organizations. In 2005, he left corporate America to pursue entrepreneurship,

founding

a medical supply business. Yet, his work extended far beyond commerce. For the past

two decades, he devoted himself to helping others—especially the most vulnerable—live with dignity, access quality care, and navigate the complexities of the

U.S. healthcare system. During some of the most difficult moments in others' lives, he

brought peace, support, and a comforting smile.

Ifiok's heart for service extended into his community, where he gave generously of his

time and resources. He was an active member of Mboho Ndito Ibibio, a socio-cultural

organization committed to unity, vision, and service. He frequently drove others to

medical appointments, donated vital equipment to his church, and had a unique gift for

making people feel seen, supported, and uplifted—often through his laughter and

encouragement.

As a father, Ifiok lovingly nurtured his children in the ways of the Lord. He modeled a

relationship with God, taught scripture, and offered unwavering guidance and support.

His legacy is one of love, faith, generosity, and integrity.

Ifiok is survived by his beloved children: Emediong, Eti-Ini, EkomAbasi, Edima, Eno-

Otto, DianaAbasi, and Mfoniso; and his cherished grandson, Jaxon. He is also survived

by his stepmother, Deaconess Christiana Effiong Enyong; three brothers: Enamidem,

Mfonn, and Edet; seven sisters: Nkereke, Ini, Emem, Uduak, Edoama, Nduehe, and Nsembowo; and a host of cousins, nieces, nephews, and other extended family members.
