On May 4, 1928, Mr. James Leon Avery, affectionately known as “Jim Avery”, was born to the late Leon Avery and Maude Estelle Avery in Refugio, Texas. James attended Barefield Schools in Refugio. He later entered the military on March 1, 1946 to serve his country in the United States Armed Forces – Army branch of service. James was baptized at an early age and later in life became an ordained deacon in the Baptist Church. He was a faithful member of Ephphatha Baptist Church now Fresh Impact Christian Church where he served as a deacon until his health failed him.

James Avery retired from the City of Austin after working in the Animal Control Department over the span of 25 years.
