James “Thomas” Jarrett was born on February 20, 1952, in St. Louis, Missouri. He spent his formative years in the St. Louis public school system and graduated from Vashon High School.

During his young adult years, Brother Jarrett developed a deep love for music—especially Jazz and Blues. He was a natural leader and a dedicated Sunday School teacher, sharing his faith and wisdom with others. His ministry extended beyond the church walls as he faithfully preached in prisons for many years, offering hope and encouragement to those in need.

Brother Jarrett proudly served his country in the United States Armed Forces, entering active duty on October 24, 1974, and being honorably released from duty on October 24, 1978.

Brother Jarrett answered his divine calling and was ordained as a minister at Mt. Zion Baptist Church on August 15, 2005, where he served faithfully for 15 years.

“Thomas” was united in holy matrimony to Evon Banks, and their love—bonded by God—remained steadfast and unbreakable until the end.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Hazel T. and Gloster L. Jarrett, and his siblings Clyde, Harold, Archie, and Reatha Peete.

He leaves to cherish his precious memory: his devoted wife, Evon; his daughter, Jawanda Jarrett of Fort Worth, Texas; his sisters, Hazel Simmons

(Raymond) and Carol Banks, both of St. Louis, Missouri; along with a host of grandchildren, nieces, nephews, friends, and church family who will forever hold his memory close to their hearts.

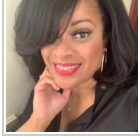
