Jeanette was born in Austin, Texas on February 5, 1951 to Trellis Carson, Sr. and Virginia G. Brady.

Jeanette accepted Christ in her life at an early age becoming a member of Sledge Chapel Baptist Church, under the leadership of Reverend Reginald Wade, Sr.

Jeanette worked in the 70's as part of the semiconductor group at Motorola, later she worked as a bus driver for the Austin Independent School District. Jeanette found her true niche in life as one of the first DJs that started with KAZI 88.7 FM (Austin, TX) and "Lady J" as she was known to her audience hosted the blues show every Wednesday from 6PM to 9PM. She loved the Blues and took pride in the fact that she had interview most of the artist that it was hers to play on the air. Two of her most enjoyable artist; Otis Clay and Solomon Burke were also friends of hers.

Jeanette was preceded in death by her father Trellis Carson, Sr., mother Virginia G. Brady and her brother Freddie L. Brady.

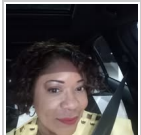
