The Life of Deacon Johnnie Mims

Deacon Johnnie Roy Mims was the fifth of six children born to Carlton Mims and Bessie Palmer on January 9, 1936 in Mexia, Texas

He attended Furney Richardson High School and later relocated to Dunbar High where he graduated.

He worked for Southern Union Gas Company for 30 years of dedicated service. After his retirement, he began his own company, "Mims Lawn Service", that he maintained until his health declined. His slogan was "Cutting Grass is What I Do".

Deacon Mims married Pinkie B. Nelms in 1957 and to this union eight children were born.

He joined Smith Chapel C.O.G.I.C. under the leadership of Pastor D.L. Smith in 1970 which was later renamed Mims Chapel under the leadership of the late Pastor Carlton Mims.

He later married Catharine Weston on April 6, 1993. Three additional children were added to this union.

Deacon Mims is preceded in death by his parents Carlton and Bessie Mims; first wife Pinkie Nelms Mims; his second wife Catherine Weston Mims; son Kenneth Roy Mims, daughter Marilyn Mims and step-daughter Michelle Cotton Penn; brothers Pastor Carlton Mims and Reverend Howard Mims; and sister Annie Pearl Carter

He leaves to cherish his precious memories his children, Toressa Nelms (Edna, Texas), Johnnie Mims (Austin, Texas.), Gloria Mims, Brenda Mims, Lester Mims and Larry Mims (all of Austin, Texas.), Step-children Darryl F.
