On December 28, 1944, the late Armor Smith and Georgia R. "Dut" Bunton was blessed with a daughter, Joyce E. "Tootie" Smith. She was the second of five children (two sisters and two brothers)

Joyce met and married Roy Lee Bolton Sr. in 1971, in Dallas County, and to this union one child was born. Mr. Bolton preceded his wife in death.

Joyce was very active in school, especially in high school. She attended L.C. Anderson High, home of the mighty yellow jackets which she loved very much. She was involved in many activities which included Miss Anderson, class of '63, Junior Red Cross, New Homemakers of America, the mixed Chorus, Acrobatic Club; Jackettes class treasurer, Y-teen, Boosters Club, school monitor, usher and guide. Also Joyce was the vice-president of OLCAAA-Original L.C. Anderson National Alumni Association.

She accepted Christ at an early age and was baptized at Pilgrim Rest Primitive Baptist Church under the leadership of Pastor Miles until she moved to Pleasant Grove Missionary Baptist Church, under the leadership of Pastor J.J. Dixon. Joyce was in the choir, Mission II, a Greeter, and secretary of Sunday school. Joyce faithfully paid her tithes along with attending many, many church activities through the years.

Joyce was employed for over thirty years at Texas Instrument and was later employed by Capital Metro for over ten years.

Saturday morning, July 03, 2021, Joyce “Tootie” heard the Masters call and answered the summons of her Lord and Savior to come on home and find sweet rest from all her labor.

Joyce was preceded in death by her sister, Anna Smith and brother, Gene “Lump” Smith.
