Mrs. Juanita Farr Mungin, daughter of the late Alonzo Johnson and Nannie Etheleen Chimilio was born August 29, 1940 in Spartanburg, South Carolina. She entered her eternal rest to be with the Lord on Sunday, January 12, 2020 at the home of daughter Sarita Burks.

The family relocated to Manhattan, New York where Juanita graduated from George Washington High School. On August 30, 1958 she was united in holy matrimony to Sgt. Thomas Mungin, Jr. United States Airforce. This union was blessed with 4 children.

Juanita professed her faith in Jesus Christ and joined Bethel Methodist AME Church, Manhattan, New York where she was a dedicated member and served faithfully as an usher.

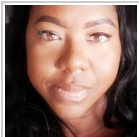
