April 21, 1936 - August 28, 2015

Katie Mae Hall was born April 21, 1936 in San Marcos, Texas to Althia Davis and Fay Mack. She was the youngest of five children and the only girl which she thoroughly enjoyed. Katie was proud of her alma mater San Marcos Colored High School also known as Dunbar High School where she graduated valedictorian and reigned as Miss San Marcos High. She wrote in her 1954 student record – “I intend to pursue a nursing career.” After traveling with her family to duty stations across the country and Japan, finally retiring in Austin and seeing her children through college graduation she fulfilled her dream receiving her Licensed Vocational Nurse Degree from Austin Community College in 1982. Her place of work was listed as Brackenridge Hospital but her rounds to meet the needs of the sick and shut-in included the Austin community at large and surrounding counties.

During her senior year in high school, Katie met Airman Bruce Edward Hall from South Carolina. They were united in Holy Matrimony, September 8, 1954 in Lockhart, TX. To this union three children were born, Bruce, Jr, “Sonny”, Linda Fay and Terri Lynn who passed away shortly after birth. Katie supported her children in little league, scouts, drill team, Junior Achievement and of course any and all church activities.

Katie united with Jackson Chapel United Methodist Church at an early age. She participated in Sunday school and Methodist Youth Fellowship. Upon

marriage, she was baptized and joined her husband in the Baptist denomination. She faithfully served in church whether in Colorado, Texas, Japan, California, Missouri and back to Colorado to complete the circle. The family joined East Nineteenth Street Missionary Baptist in 1973 when Bruce Hall retired from the United States Air Force and moved to Austin to be closer to Katie's mother. Over the years, Katie has served as a devoted member of Mission II, Junior Usher Sponsor, Prayer Ministry Chair and as a Deaconess. She has mentored many young women ensuring her legacy will go on.

Katie Mae Hall was preceded in death by her beloved husband of 59 years, Bruce Edward Hall, Sr. She leaves to cherish her memory: son, Bruce Edward Hall, Jr. (Gwen), daughter, Linda Fay Howelton, M.D. (Russell), grandsons Aaron Hall (Amanda), Bryan Jones, Jared Howelton, Devin Jones, Zachary Howelton and Gregory Hall.
