Kimberly Michon Bellinger was born to Carl and Ceceila Bellinger on October 25, 1970 in Austin, Texas. As a child, she attended St. Mary's Catholic School, then Blackshear and Blanton Elementary Schools in the Austin Independent School District. It was during this time that her parents discovered Kimberly was quite an artistic and talented child. She took ballet, gymnastics and dance classes, which were her passions as a young girl. She later attended Pearce Junior High School and went on to attend LBJ High School, where she was a member of the "First Ladies", the school's dance and cheerleading team. She would graduate LBJ High School in 1989.

In 1994, Kimberly would celebrate the birth of her only child, Christian, with his father, Dexter Bartley. A few years later, Kimberly followed her passion for the beauty arts and enrolled as a student at Baldwin Beauty Schools in 2000.

After a few years behind the chair as a hairstylist, she returned to Baldwin in 2002 to become an instructor. In a career that spanned over two decades, she inspired and propelled many promising and successful young professionals through not only her wealth of knowledge in the field, but her devotion to helping people believe in themselves and their abilities. She dedicated her life to cultivating loving relationships with the people she loved and cared for most.
