



## Marquel Rashad-Jerome Rose

Marquel Rashad-Jerome Rose passed away on Wednesday, June 11, 2025. He was born in Austin, Texas, on July 7, 1991, to Andrea Monique Rose. At age 6, Marquel accepted Christ as his Lord and Savior and was baptized at Sweet Home Baptist Church. He attended public schools in Round Rock, Texas, where he played football in middle and high school. He was a member of the Stoney Point High School Choir. After high school, he attended Temple Jr. College in Temple, TX, where he studied music and theater. He continued his musical studies at the University of Texas at San Antonio (UTSA). He also attended the Austin Graduate School of Theology, where he began his theological studies. On Sunday, June 23, 2013, he was licensed to preach the Gospel by Dr. Dante D. Wright I, Senior Pastor, Sweet Home - The Pinnacle of Praise, where he served as an associate minister.

Marquel was an active member of GMWA (Texas) until he relocated to Oklahoma City, OK, in 2019 to serve as the Minister of Music at Tabernacle Baptist Church. Soon after moving to Oklahoma, he became an active member of GMWA in Oklahoma City, OK. In 2023, Marquel moved to Spartanburg, SC, to serve as the Minister of Music at Mt. Moriah Baptist Church. While there, he became a member of the GMWA Upstate in Spartanburg, SC and he was active in discipling and mentoring the youth and young adults at Mt. Moriah. He was also on the initial planning team for the

Young Adult Ministry.
