He met and married the Love of his Life in 1996, and remained married until he preceded her in death. Marvin moved to Texas in 2001. He worked for Capital Metro as a Sr. Diesel Mechanic for over 15 years.

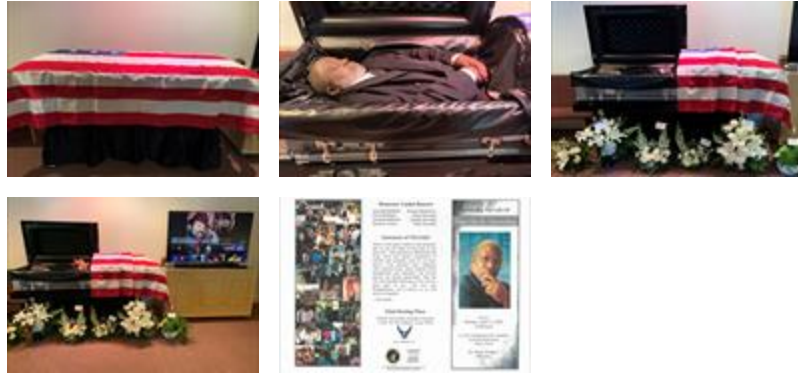
