



## Mattie Beatrice McShan

December 9, 1927 - September 4, 2016

Mattie Beatrice (Simmons) McShan was born December 19, 1927 to John Simmons and Beatrice Anderson in Lee County, Texas. She began and continued her education at Post Oak School, Antioch School, Ledbetter, Texas and Washington High School, Elgin, Texas.

She professed Jesus Christ as her lord and savior at an early age. She was baptized by the late Rev. Lucas of Caldwell, Texas. She became a member of the New England Baptist Church of Ledbetter, Texas. She later moved to Elgin, Texas with her parents and joined the Winn's Memorial Baptist Church with the leadership of the late Rev. G. M. Releford. Her father was one of the deacons during that time.

She attended Booker T. Washington High School and met a young man named ElRoy McShan in 1946. She thought he was an odd ball, but never realized they would get hitched. They got married in October 1950. She worked as a maid in Elgin, and Austin, Texas.

She worked at Golden Years Nursing Home and retired at Travis State School. She also worked at Oak Crest Nursing Center in Manor, Texas. She worked hard to support her husband in the ministry. She was an excellent pastor's wife. Her husband, the late, Pastor E. R. McShan, pastored the Pleasant Hill Baptist Church, Sayersville, Texas for 44 years and the Mt. Zion Baptist Church, Plum, Texas for 40 years. He also pastored Pear Valley Baptist Church, Coupland, Texas.

McShan; her; daughter, Bertha Beatrice McShan-Jackson; son, Rev. Eljay McShan.
