You had better be paying attention because he had a joy of scaring people.

As a published author, in 2018, he penned his first book about personal pain, "Love Poetry and Every Level Speaks". Despite his health challenges, he confronted them head on with the help of his family. Michael was a fighter, he fought to the end, and he had unshakable faith.

The agape love Michael had for others was immeasurable. Like Christ Michael had a servant's heart, therefore, his love was not "lip service" but in his actions, thoughts, and his deeds. He departed this life on January 14, 2023, at 9:45 pm.
