



## Dr. Ricky Daniel Seaborn

September 29, 1958 - August 28, 2015

Reverend Dr. Ricky Daniel Seaborn, was born on September 29, 1958 in Taylor, Texas; he was the second youngest child of the late Margaret Seaborn-Barnett of Taylor, Texas and David Seaborn of Stone Mountain, Georgia. Pastor Seaborn departed this life in the early morning hours on Friday, August 28, 2015 at the age of 56.

Pastor Seaborn gave his life to Christ as a child and was baptized at the tender age of eight years old. He was a faithful member of Olivet Baptist Church in Austin, Texas under the leadership and inspiration of Reverend Lawrence V. Wicks, where Pastor Seaborn's relationship with God was rooted. Pastor Seaborn's fiery passion for God, desire to further his studies of God's word, and spread the gospel to the world, were evident to all who knew him.

Pastor Seaborn graduated from the historic Stephen F. Austin High School in the Austin Independent School District and began his professional career with the Internal Revenue Service in the mid-1980's. As a young adult, Pastor Seaborn moved to Georgia, transferring to the Atlanta Service Center located in Chamblee, Georgia in 1988; he retired in 2011 as the Chief of Planning and Analysis Operations for Submission Processing.

He became a member of Mount Vernon Baptist Church in Atlanta, Georgia

under the leadership of Pastor S.A. Baker. He later transitioned to Cornerstone Community Baptist Church in Atlanta, Georgia under the leadership of W. J. Lawson. Pastor Seaborn was called as pastor of the Basket Creek Baptist Church in Douglasville, Georgia where he served faithfully for 25 years until his death.

Pastor Seaborn's legacy of love and servanthood will forever be cherished by his loving and devoted wife, Erma D. Seaborn; 11 siblings – Barbara Wesley-Selby (Foye) of Austin, Texas; Sheryl Seaborn-Simmons (Clarence) of Douglasville, Georgia; David Seaborn (Jacqueline) of Austin, Texas; Michael Seaborn (Rosalinda) of Austin, Texas; and siblings in Atlanta, GA, David Strozier (Janie); Reginald Strozier (Lucinda); David Gresham; Bonnie Anderson; Kim Seaborn; Gwendale Strozier, Missy Gresham, a host of nieces, nephews, relatives, members of the Basket Creek Baptist Church, and friends.
