Robbie Lee Henderson Williams was born July 21, 1925 to Lavalda Henderson and Hattie Taylor Henderson in Smithville, Texas. She attended Smithville Public Schools. She accepted Christ as Lord and Savior at an early age. Robbie and Clarence Williams joined in holy matrimony on May 24, 1944. To this union one daughter was born, Carroll Ann.

Robbie was a dedicated “Doorkeeper” for many years at Greater Mt. Zion Baptist Church. She worked tirelessly as an Usher, many times traveling with the pastor when visiting surrounding churches until her health declined. She worked for many years at the Sperry Hutchinson Company (S & H Green Stamps). Many people remember her as the “green stamp lady.”

Robbie was reared during The Great Depression and she never forgot the valuable lessons of close family relations and the importance of stretching a dollar. No matter her financial circumstances, she always dressed to impress. She lived through the tough times of the Jim Crow Era, The Civil Rights Movement, the first Black President and she survived the COVID years. Robbie was loved not only by her family, but by many others she met along the way. She was an excellent cook and will be remembered for her fried chicken, chocolate cake and sweet potato pie. When she entertained guests, they often left with a smile and a full belly.

She was the last of her generation and was preceded in death by her parents,

each of her siblings: brothers, Rufus Henderson and Warren Henderson, sisters, Estelle Fowler, Madie Freeman, Artessia Lincoln, Virda Woods, Willie Ruth Fowler, Gladys Rivers and Charlene Daniels.

Robbie departed this life on March 25, 2023. She is survived by her daughter, Carroll Brown of Pflugerville, Texas, grandsons, Chris Brown (Tracie) of Hutto, Texas and Clint Brown of Pflugerville, Texas, great granddaughters, Charlize Brown of Del Valle, Texas and Camdyn Brown of Hutto, Texas as well as a host of nieces, nephews, other relatives and friends.
