



## Ruby Inell Pittmon

August 19, 1950 - January 12, 2017

Ruby fondly known as Nell was the eldest of two children born to Abel Pittmon and Vera King Pittmon on August 19, 1950 in Cameron, Texas. She confessed her faith in Jesus Christ at an early age.

Ruby attended school in Cameron, Rockdale, and Oklahoma City. On April 16, 1968, she was blessed with her only child, a son Ben Pittmon known as "lil man". With God on her side Ruby dedicated her life to raising him into the man he had become. After God, her son and family were most important to her.

In 1973, she began working at the Austin State School. After 17 years she retired and continued working at numerous facilities throughout the Austin community as a caregiver to the MHMR community and the Austin School for the Blind.

In 1990, she started the tradition of the King Family Reunion which rotates annually between Rockdale and Abilene. Ruby loved music. She enjoyed card games and watching John Wayne western movies. She was a collector of angel figurines, African American art, and fine crystal. But she was most proud of her stylist hat collection.

In 2006, she joined her son and became a member of the Eastside Baptist Church of Austin, TX under the leadership of Pastor Leland Dandridge. There she served on the Young at Heart Ministry and Vacation Bible School Registry until her health began to fail in 2011. Ruby spent her recent years at the Hearthstone Health Center where she made many friends and actively

participated in community events.

Ruby was preceded in death by her parents, paternal and maternal grandparents, two sisters Linda Crawford and Beverly Moore-Gunnels, and her son Ben Pittmon.
