Sarah Christine (Walker) Alexander was born May 9, 1931 to Reverend John Walker and Anna Ethridge in Williamson County, Texas. She attended Blackshear/O.L. Price from the beginning of her education through graduation in Taylor, Texas. She professed Jesus Christ as her Lord and Savior at an early age, and she was baptized by her father Reverend John Walker in Taylor, Texas. After graduation from O. L. Price she attended Huston-Tillotson University and later received training from the Sisters of Holy Cross to become an X-ray Technician at Brackenridge Hospital and later St. David's Hospital; she was one of if not the first African American X-ray Technician in Central Texas. Sarah decided to begin a new career and worked at Travis State School and later at Austin Independent School District (AISD) from which she retired. Prior to retirement she continued her education at Austin Community College where she took child development courses to supplement her training at AISD. She attended Pilgrim Rest Primitive Baptist Church where she worked with the youth department sewing costumes for plays for Christmas and Easter programs. She also worked alongside other youth department members to provide speeches for the Christmas and Easter programs. Sarah was preceded in death by her father Reverend John Walker, mother Anna Walker, and brother Herman Walker. She leaves to cherish her memories: her daughter and only child Valerie Alexander Jackson, her son-in-

law Larry Jackson, granddaughters: Jessica Christine Jackson of Houston, TX, Jade Alexander (Jackson) Brownel of Atlanta, GA, and Josephine Nicollette Jackson of Lexington, TX; and her grandson: Josiah Jentel Jarlan Jackson of Austin, TX (who moved in with her to care for her until she moved to Lexington, TX with her daughter).
