Obituary of Mother Sophie Sorrells Ross

Sophie Ross (aka Tiny or Mother Ross) was born to Hattie Dallas Sorrells and Calvin Sorrells, on August 25, 1937, in Taylor, Texas. Sophie was the youngest of seven siblings. She was married in Holy Matrimony to Charles Ross (Pony) in 1963 and together they raised two daughters and one son. They were married 31 years. Mother Sophie Ross passed away peacefully as she transitioned from this life to eternity on Thursday, November 9, 2023, at the age of 86.

Sophie attended public school in Williamson County and graduated with honors from O. L. Price High School in 1955. In later years, she earned a Physical Therapist license. She held several jobs as a physical therapist in various skilled nursing homes in the beginning years of her career. She retired from the Trinity Care Center (formerly, Trinity Lutheran Nursing Home) of Round Rock after more than 20 years of service.

Sophie was saved in her youth and lived a devoted Christian life. For many years she was a member of Zion Chapel Missionary Baptist Church under the leadership of Rev. J. B. Smith.

She confessed a strong faith in the Lord. God was the head of her life and she put Him first in everything she did. Two of her favorite hymns were Leaning on

the Everlasting Arms and Order My Steps.

Sophie moved her membership to the Mt. Calvary Missionary Baptist Church in 1997 and served faithfully for more than 25 years until her death, under the leadership of her son, Pastor Tony Sorrells, Sr. Mother Ross enjoyed the esteemed favor of being the Pastor's Mother and she remained a faithful servant of the Lord and devoted member of Mt. Calvary. She loved the Lord and the Church, and she served with distinction, gladness, humility, and excellence in her many roles. She served as a member of the Board of Directors, as Deaconess, Sunday School Teacher, and was elevated to Church Mother. Mother Ross gave faithfully her tithes and offerings unto the Lord, served in the women's auxiliaries, taught bible study, prepared and served countless meals, and she was a part of the hospitality committee. She always supported the youth by cooking and contributing to all fundraisers and summer camps, and she encouraged and trained many other young women to serve faithfully in the church with excellence. She loved reading her bible, studying, and teaching the Word of God. Mother Ross prayed daily and often fasted. When her health declined and she could no longer physically attend service in person, she remained a faithful supporter and joined Facebook so that she could be a part of the streaming community and stay connected.

Mother Ross loved life and her family. She enjoyed completing word puzzles, watching game shows, and soap operas (Young & the Restless was her favorite), looking up recipes and creating her own, and cooking so she could feed anyone who stopped by for a visit, especially for a slice of her homemade pineapple cake. She enjoyed spending time with her family and Thanksgiving was her favorite holiday to bring everyone together. Sophie always wanted the best for everyone and always saw the good in people. She always prayed for those whom she loved. She was a woman with much wisdom. Mother Ross exemplified the Proverbs 31 Woman. "Many women do noble things, but you surpass them all." Charm is deceptive, and beauty is

fleeting, but a woman who fears the LORD is to be praised. Honor her for all that her hands have done, and let her works bring her praise at the city gate. (Proverbs 31: 29-31, NIV)

Sophie was preceded in death by her parents Hattie Dallas Sorrells and Calvin Sorrells; her husband Charles Ross, Jr., (Pony); her grandmother Mary Elizabeth Minerva-Dallas; her great-grandparent Laura Dallas; her siblings, Laura Smith, Rosie Lee Williams Mitchell, and Gracie Martin, Edward Morgan (Didlum), Willie Johnson, and Jack Martin, and great grandchild Derrick Thomas.
