He was deployed to the Gulf War and was later stationed at Fort Hood, Texas. Victor joined the Texas Army National Guard in 1996. He was deployed to many countries and received several honors and accolades. He later established his career with the Travis County Sheriff's Office as a Correctional Officer/Deputy Sheriff, where he successfully retired in 2020. Victor enjoyed serving his country while being a citizen soldier, working out, traveling, gardening and spending time with his family. Victor never met a stranger and had a humorous personality bigger than life. Victor was a cherished father to De Jonae Johnson. In 1998 he married Latresa Johnson, and they raised Jessica, Jerrod, Danielle, and De Jonae as one. He was affectionately known as "PaPa" to their grandchildren, Adrianna, Tiara, Jayden, and Autumn.
