Warren Leroy “Undercover Brother” Anderson of Coupland went home to be at rest, August 24, 2015 at 4:58 p.m.

Warren was born September 22, 1950 in Baltimore Maryland. He was oldest child born to Thomas Leroy and Lillian Eunice Anderson. He received Christ at an early age.

He attended the Baltimore Public School System, graduating from the Forest Park High School. He went on to enlist in the U.S. Marine Corps from 1969 to 1971 with an honorable discharge. He re-enlisted in the U.S. Air Force in 1972 and retired in 1990. He worked with the U.S. Postal Service for 23 years as a Letter Carrier, Mail Handler and Maintenance Mechanic. He retired in 2015 due to his failing health.

Warren loved riding his Harley Davidson Ultra Classic Motorcycle. Warren was an instrumental founding member in starting the Annual Austin/Houston/San Antonio Motorcycle Group Child Protective Services Toy Run every year. He started the Annual Thanksgiving Turkey Trot Run. Warren was a member of the Houston2Wheelers Austin Chapter (H2W Austin). He was a member of the Austin Postal Service Bowling Team.

He was preceded in death by his grandmother, Myrtle B. Williams, his father Thomas L. Anderson and his brother Arvine H. Anderson.

He is survived by his loving wife, Sonda Anderson, sons Anthony and Darrell (Ariana) Anderson, step-sons Terence Young, Jr. and Alex (Michelle) Young, grandchildren Julian Vargas, Natalia and Brooklyn Anderson, cousins Michael (Curline) and Sonny Anderson.
